Update: HOA Management Company

Earlier this year, the HOA Board sent out a request for proposals for an HOA management company. This was due to not receiving enough volunteers to stay selfmanaged.

Two management companies responded, and over the past 3 months, the HOA Board conducted thorough due diligence with each.

A contract was signed with Veracious Management Company that will begin on October 1.
